Friday August 3rd

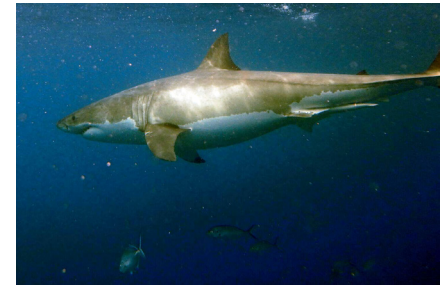

Tues May 29th & Wed May 30th

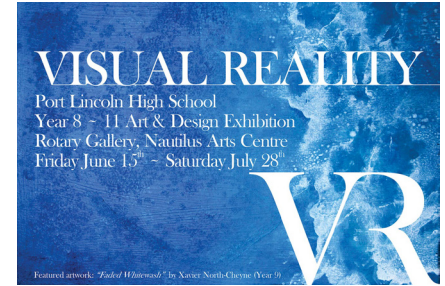

Friday June 29th

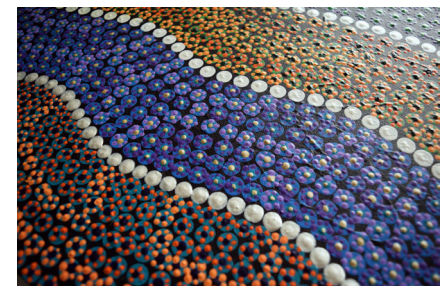

Friday March 16th

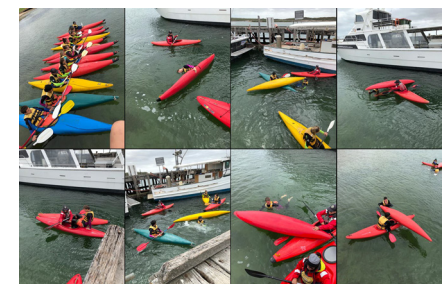

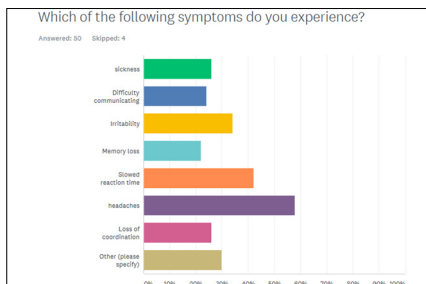
Silver Medals for Lukas & Abby Thursday June 28th
