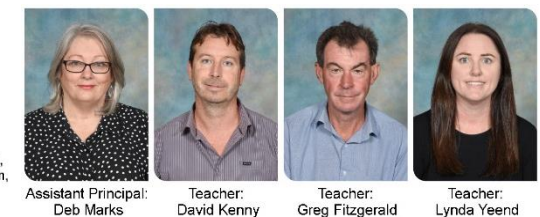


And We're Away...

Clontarf's Inaugural Awards Night

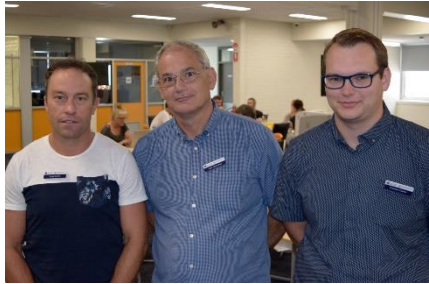
Tuesday November 12th

Room 23 Enjoys Mexican Fiesta Tuesday November 26th

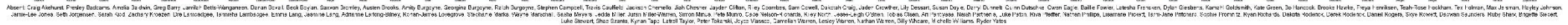
