LINC consists of a small team of specialist staff who support students and their families to engage in personalised learning. LINC is for young people who require extensive universal adjustments to access education.

LINC recognises that some young people may require an alternate approach to traditional high school education.

LINC students:

- Respond positively to extensive adjustments that support all aspects of schooling
- Access learning that meets their personal needs
- Receive holistic support to engage with education whilst at school and at other adult learning environments (eg: TAFE)

LINC can provide an alternate post-primary pathway for young people. It is aimed at young people and their families who benefit from the intensive wrap-around support provided by the Team-Around the Child framework.

TEACHING PEDAGOGY

LINC is for young people who may require substantial to extensive adjustments (as defined by the NCCD) in order to access education. This can include intensive, personalised instruction or support in a highly structured or specialised manner across curricula areas, activities and assessments within a highly modified classroom and/or school environment. There is ongoing differentiation, scaffolding and support of specialist staff. Evidenced-based frameworks inform the pedagogy.





LINC works with community organisations and other government agencies to increase education, life skills and community connections.

LINC staff can facilitate connection to:

- Alternative educational opportunities
- Community youth organisations
- Health services
- Therapeutic support
- Transition into or out of Port Lincoln High School
- Vocational or employment opportunities
